- ▶ Develop result indicators to measure and monitor the learning

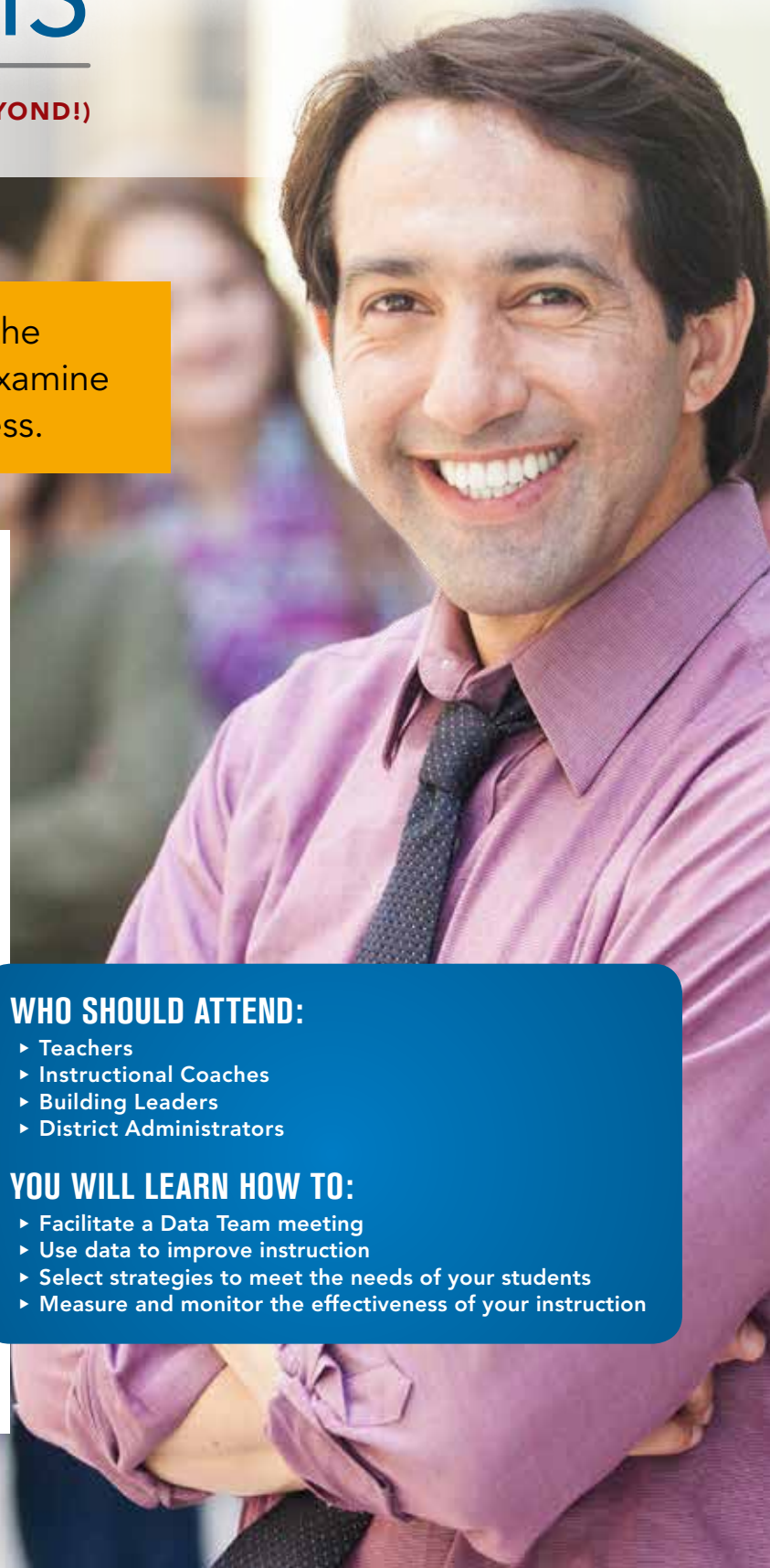
